

# PARTNER WITH YOUR LOCAL SCHOOL

Follow the 4C process to start or continue your partnership journey

## #1 Catalytic Event

### Host a Service Event

Church A partners with Together Chicago and local nonprofit partners to host a service event at School A. Together Chicago refers to these events as Love Your School days

## #2 Commit

### School Need / Church's Capacity

School A tells us their top 1-3 needs. Church A tells us if they have the capacity to serve as needed. At the end of this stage, we know exactly how School A and Church A will partner and who will champion this work on both sides.

### Share Vision with Key Leaders

School A's champion for this work tells all pertinent staff members what is needed from them for successful partnership. Church A's champion uses the plan created during step 1 to recruit the volunteers needed.
